## 1. MEMBERSHIP

Membership is open to individuals approved by the Trustees.

a) Full membership of the Charity shall be open to:

- i) Consultant Clinical and Medical Oncologists, who have paid the annual subscription laid down from time to time by the Executive Committee.
- ii) Postdoctoral Research Fellows, University Scientists under training, Career Registrars in clinical or medical oncology pursuing a career in urological oncology who are interested in furthering the work of the charity and who have paid the annual subscription laid down from time to time by the Executive Committee.

b) Associate Membership

Other individuals, namely Urologists may apply for Associate Membership.

c) Honorary Membership

Honorary membership will be granted at the discretion of the Executive Committee and will be offered to those full members deemed to have made outstanding contribution to or to the field of urological oncology. Honorary members will receive free circulation of correspondence from the British Uro-oncology Group at no subscription and will be eligible to attend British Uro-oncology Group hosted meetings.

d) Senior Membership

To be granted at the discretion of the Executive Committee and offered to any full member of the British Uro-oncology Group on reaching retirement. Senior members will receive free circulation of correspondence from BUG.

Only full members shall be entitled to vote at the Annual General Meeting. Every full member shall have one vote.

## 2. SUBSCRIPTION

All subscriptions are due on 1<sup>st</sup> January (with payment received by BUG Secretariat by 31<sup>st</sup> January) each year and run from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December.

Full members: £50.00 per annum

Associate members: £50.00 per annum

Subscriptions are set by the Executive Committee and approved by the Annual General Meeting.

## 3. TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Any member in any category who fails to pay his or her subscription within two months of the due date of payment in spite of appropriate notification shall cease to be a member of the Charity.
